R2—Good conduct in or out of classroom, above expected standards—Head of Sixth Form Award

R1—Positive engagement and contribution in class and to the personalised extended curriculum - regular Growth Mindset

VP—verbal praise for instant feedback.

CW— Conduct Warning, behaviour unacceptable for the classroom or sixth form study areas.

Logged on SIMS ↓

L1—Low level disruption; isolated attendance, punctuality, deadline issue; failure to engage with the personalised extended curriculum. Student may be moved. May be called back for detention—(Teacher responsibility)

L2—More persistent issues; more serious incident or failure to respond to previous warnings; attendance below 90%, poor punctuality. Removal from class + 30 min detention + Head of Faculty

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L3—Significant concerns due to serious one off incident or persistent attendance (<85%), punctuality, engagement or conduct issues. Removal from series of lessons or loss of series breaks and lunch times. Assistant Head of Sixth Form report. SLT detention.

L4—Isolated incident of extreme conduct or accumulation of ongoing serious disruption to the ethos of the school/sixth form. Persistent attendance (<80%), punctuality or engagement issues. Isolation and /or alternative provision interview. Head of Sixth Form contract + interview with parents. Can result in Governors Disciplinary Panel or permanent exclusion .
