Media

A career in the media sounds glamorous, but what does it really involve? There are a number of different disciplines in this industry, so you will need to decide which one is right for you before you make a decision. Roles in the media include:

- Journalist
- Editor

- Copywriter
- Presenter

Salary range

The media is not among the top paying industries. Channel 4's media apprenticeships are among the better paying and you will earn **£18,500** per annum while doing one. If you are a graduate working as a trainee producer, you can expect to earn around **£17,000 to £23,000**.
