



Core Maths

Core mathematics has been designed for those students that don't want to do A level maths but want to continue with maths after GCSE. It has been designed to ensure students have the relevant knowledge and skills to progress to further study or the world of work. It will give students a more advanced understanding of maths and how it is used in a business setting and in real world context.

Assessment

There are two papers:

Paper 1-comprehension which is 1 hour 30 minutes and has a weighting of 40%.

Paper 2-applications which is 1 hour 40 minutes and has a weighting of 60%.

This is a level 3 qualification which can be converted into UCAS points, for example an A grade in this qualification is worth 20 UCAS points and a C grade worth 12.
