Dear Parents,

I am writing to let you know about the summer term arrangements for Year 13 students.

The majority of the A2 Level exams start on **Monday 5th June**. Year 13 lessons will continue until the exam in that subject has been taken, experience tells us that being in school with access to teachers is the best practise in the build up to exams. Where an exam falls in the afternoon, the student may take off the morning of that day for study purposes. If they have a morning exam, they may go home at the end of period 4 on the previous day. This will also be the case for any students taking AS subjects and re-sitting any AS modules. Please note that the AS exams tend to start before the A Level exams. Students taking BTEC subjects will continue their lessons until the BTEC course is completed.

The BTEC, AS and A Level results will all be published on **Thursday 17th August**. Students will be able to collect their results from Wingfield Hall at 8.30 am. It is strongly advised that you are not on holiday at this time in order that you can be at the end of the phone in the event that you may need to contact universities.

I know that most students will have started their preparation for these important exams and I am sure that you are encouraging and supporting them through their revision programme. I look forward to the students achieving really good grades in the summer and to celebrating the end of their time here at the Summer Ball, to be held on Friday 7th July.
