1. A stable careers programme
2. Learning from career and labour market information
3. Addressing the needs of each pupil
4. Linking curriculum learning to careers

5. Encounters with employers and employees
6. Experiences of workplaces
7. Encounters with further and higher education
8. Personal guidance

In addition, students will be able to tap into further visits and opportunities as they arise. For example, taster days at the RUH in allied health professions, visit to the Digital Apprenticeships day at the MOD, Microsoft IT day, trip to the BBC, and the Women in Engineering day at Wiltshire College.
